The Institute of Certified Public Accountants of Singapore (“ICPAS”) recognises the following Undergraduate Degree Programme for entry into ICPAS Professional Examination (ICPAS PE) for the purpose of attaining the “CPA Singapore” designation and professional membership into ICPAS.

University: University of London (“UOL”)
Course: Bachelor of Science (Accounting & Finance)

List of units required for entry into ICPAS PE are as follows:

Financial Accounting	Principles of Accounting (replaced Elements of Accounting & Finance) AND Financial Reporting
Management Accounting	Management Accounting
Finance	Corporate Finance OR Financial Management
Auditing	Auditing
Taxation	NA
Law	Elements of the Law of Contract
Information Systems	Information Systems & Organisations
Human Resource Management	Introduction to Business & Management OR Human Resource Management
Economics	Intro to Economics AND Managerial Economics OR Microeconomics
Statistics	Statistics 1 AND Mathematics 1

Note:

- All applications are subjected to assessment by the ICPAS Board of Education & Examiners (the “Board”).
- Both** Principles of Accounting (replaced Elements of Accounting and Finance) **and** Financial Reporting units must be attempted and passed prior to application for entry into ICPAS PE. Exemptions for the above units are not considered as attempts.
- For exemption of units other than Principles of Accounting (replaced Elements of Accounting and Finance) and Financial Reporting, the Board will assess the exemptions on a case-by-case basis.

Qualifying subject recommendations may be made to successful applicants where necessary, in addition to the 5 modules of the ICPAS PE.
